

AMERICAN LEGION - UMPIRE'S EJECTION REPORT

Use the form below to submit an ejection report. Submit a separate report for each person ejected. Reports should be submitted as soon as possible after the incident **(no later than 48 hours)**.

The umpire responsible for the ejection shall **call** their board's designated contact (Summer Assignor) the day or evening of the game to report the incident. Within 48 hours of the game, the umpire shall complete the Umpire's Ejection Report and e-mail it to their board's designated contact (Summer Assignor) for review and submission of the report to the CT American Legion Officials. The board's designated contact shall review the report and forward via email to the respective Zone Chairman and CT State American Legion Director of Baseball.

The Zone Chairman will notify the offending team's coach or general manager of the suspension penalty based upon CT American Legion Rule 8.
